

Expanded Services Provided

Medica

- Over the counter medications
- Diagnosis, treatment and triage of injuries, order x-rays if needed
- Diagnosis and treatment of illnesses: strep throat, ear infections, headaches, and anemia (The nurse practitioner is able to write/call in prescriptions if they are needed for treatment.)
- Nurse practitioner works in conjunction with your doctor
- Assistance with chronic conditions such as diabetes asthma (including school asthma plans), and eating disorders
- Provision of routine lab tests such as threat cultures urine screening for infection and screening for anemia
- Health education, counseling and wellmess promotion
- Vaccinations for uninsured, underinsured and Maine Care clients
- Flu shots
- Routine physical exams, including sports and camp physicals
- Reproductive health counseling
- Annual Health Risk Assessment and counseling appointments and walk-ins welcome

Mental Health

- Mental health counseling (additional parental consent required). Your insurance will be billed.
 Help with co-pay may be available
- "Teen Screen" a nationally recognized program for screening for suicide risk in adolescents (additional parental consent required)

Enrollment Information

- All students are eligible for enrollment
- Annual parental permission required unless student is 18 years old
