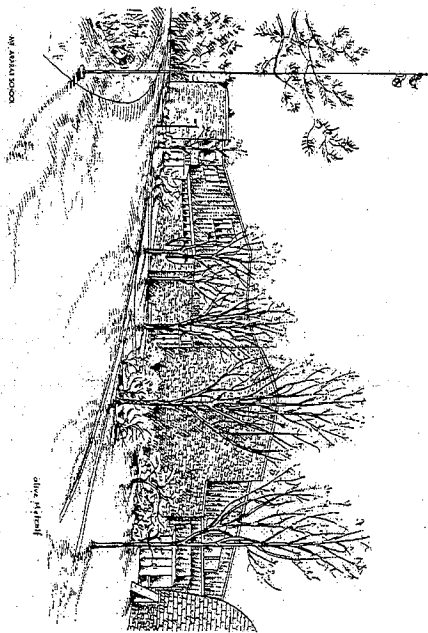

## Expanded Services Provided

### **Medical**

- Over the counter medications
- Diagnosis, treatment and triage of injuries, order x-rays if needed
- Diagnosis and treatment of illnesses: strep throat, ear infections, headaches, and anemia (*The nurse practitioner is able to write/call in prescriptions if they are needed for treatment*)
- Nurse practitioner works in conjunction with your doctor
- Assistance with chronic conditions such as diabetes, asthma (including school asthma plans), and eating disorders
- Provision of routine lab tests such as throat cultures, urine screening for infection and screening for anemia
- Health education, counseling and wellness promotion
- Vaccinations for uninsured, underinsured and Maine Care clients
- Flu shots
- Routine physical exams, including sports and camp physicals
- Reproductive health counseling
- Annual Health Risk Assessment and counseling appointments and walk-ins welcome

### **Mental Health**

- Mental health counseling (additional parental consent required). Your insurance will be billed. Help with co-pay may be available.
- "Teen Screen" a nationally recognized program for screening for suicide risk in adolescents (additional parental consent required)

### **Dental**

- Oral health screenings, treatment and referral by a Registered Hygienist

## Enrollment Information

- All students are eligible for enrollment
- Annual parental permission required unless student is 18 years old

### **Fees**

- Annual enrollment fee of \$20.00 (unless you have Maine Care)
- Family Discount: \$20.00 first student, \$10.00 Each additional student

### **Insurances billed through the SBHC**

- Maine Care, Aetna, Anthem/Blue Cross and Cigna

### **Financial benefit to join?**

- No Co-pay
- You'll never receive a bill
- If your insurance is billed, it will be applied towards your deductible
- You will not have to leave work for your child to be seen and treated by the nurse practitioner

### **Confidentiality**

We strongly recommend parental participation, however all medical records containing information regarding mental health, substance abuse treatment and reproductive health care must be kept confidential by law, just as in your doctor's office. No information is shared with school staff without your permission.
