

FOR AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) GRANTEES

The following information was sent to ARRA Grantees funded by OVW. The highlighted section pertains to the semi-annual (Tribal Governments, Tribal and State Coalitions, Transitional Housing) and annual (STOP Administrator and STOP Subgrantee) progress reporting forms to be completed by grantees. You will find forms, instructions and information on training and technical assistance on this website. What and When to Report

OVW ARRA grantees must also submit progress and financial reporting requirements required of all OVW grantees, in addition to the quarterly reporting requirements under section 1512 of the ARRA. The OVW progress and financial reports must be submitted directly to OVW through the Grants Management System (GMS).

The following reports must be submitted by all OVW ARRA grantees:

(a) Semi-annual progress reports (due January 30 and July 30 for most ARRA grantees) and annual progress reports (March 30 for the STOP Formula grant program);

(b) Quarterly financial reports (formerly called SF-269s, formerly due 45 days after the end of a quarter), due October 30, 2009 and thereafter 30 days after the end of each quarter; and

(c) Section 1512 ARRA reports, due 10 days after the end of each quarter and to be submitted through www.Federalreporting.gov.
